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Pre-trip Checklist

- Passport (must be valid 6 months after trip - until Oct 15, 2024)
- Enroll in STEP (step.state.gov/step) - Optional
- Verify flight details
- Spiritual Preparation (do what you are called to do)
 - _____ (Eg. Daily Mass, Rosary, Fast, Confession, Bible, Divine Mercy Novena)
- Notify credit card companies + bank (debit card)
 - Tell them each country you will visit (depending on your flights: Germany, France, UK, Croatia, **Bosnia & Herzegovina**)
 - Ask: Will I be charged foreign transaction fees?
 - Ask: What exchange rate will I get?
- Take pictures of documents; *Save online or with family*
 - Passport
 - Driver's license
 - Credit cards
 - Health cards
- Pack (see separate packing list)
- Install phone apps
 - Messaging App(s) — **WhatsApp**, twitter, facebook messenger, Google Voice, etc.
 - iBreviary** (for daily Mass readings, and other prayers)
 - Google Translate (install languages: Croatian, maybe Spanish, Italian, German)
 - Google Maps w/ ***Offline Maps*** for Medjugorje, Bosnia and Herzegovina
 - Airline App; Login to make sure you have access
 - Credit Card & Bank Apps; Login to check also
- Arrangements while you are gone (mail, pets, plants, etc.)
- Prepare house if nobody will be home (heat / locks / lights / etc)
- Get lots of sleep several nights before the trip!
- Remove stuff from wallet/purse that you won't need on the trip
- Check-in the 24hrs early (airline website or airline phone app)

Packing List

Packing less means less to carry/worry about. You won't need much. Check the weather for Medjugorje (sometimes Međugorje) or Čitluk (**April avg high: 65°F, avg low: 45°F**). Below is a recommended list, and a link to a bigger list (that you should not need 😊).

Check your airline carry-on / checked bag size limits. Most allow 1 Carry-on (overhead), 1 Personal Item (under seat), and sometimes free checked bags. An example of size limits (Turkish Airlines):

- **Carry-on Size:** 55cm x 40cm x 23cm (about 21.5" x 15.7" x 9") ← 17.5 lbs
- **Personal Item Size:** 40cm x 30cm x 15cm (about 15.7" x 11.8" x 6")
- **Checked Bag:** 158cm (L + W + H) (about 62") ← 50 lbs

Do not use luggage w/ batteries.

- Travel paperwork (this doc, tickets, **passport**, itinerary, insurance/medical documents, etc.)
- About 5-7 Shirts
- Socks & underwear
- 3-7 pairs of shorts / pants / dresses
- Hat (can buy there, good for shade), belt
- Shoes - comfortable for hiking on rocks
- Toiletries (travel-size liquids in **quart-sized** ziplock!)
 - Toothpaste & toothbrush
 - Shaver
 - Deodorant

- Reading Glasses, Sun Glasses
- Cell phone + charging cable (wifi is widely available)
- Power Adapter (optional) - **Type F** recommended, perhaps w/ USB plug for your phone
- Tech stuff, cords, chargers (headphones for plane, iPad, camera, memory cards, etc.)
- Portable FM radio w/ earphones or headphones (94.3 FM for English)**
- Vitamins (C, D3, Zinc Sulfate, etc.), Medications (bring prescriptions)
- Money (for gifts, extra food, taxis, etc) — ATMs will be available, you don't need to bring much.
- Credit Cards + ATM card (**know & test your PIN**)

Travel Tips

Below are some travel tips. It assumes you've done the pre-trip checklist and have packed already.

Before your trip

- Know your itinerary. Helps you be at the right place at the right time.
- Get lots of sleep for a few nights leading up to the trip.
- Be Early. Especially for planes, they won't wait for you.
 - **Check-in closes about 1 hr before departure — arrive at airport 3 hours early.**
- Check-in as soon as possible (**24 hr before flight**) for best seats.
- If you check a bag, assume it will be lost... pack everything you **NEED** in your carry-on.
- Pack for TSA inspection:
 - Put liquids in 1 quart-sized ziplock (max 3.4 oz including sunscreen, 1 ziplock / person). Pack w/ easy access.
 - Avoid prohibited items (no aerosols, batteries greater than 100WH, Galaxy Note 7, Walking Sticks, see TSA list)

Airport & plane flight

- Prep for security. Before the TSA checkpoint:
 - Put everything you are holding in your carry-on (belt, wallet, money, phone, hat, watch, jacket).
 - Hold your ID and ticket.
 - Unless told otherwise, place laptops, iPads separately through X-ray machine (in their own bin).
 - Read the signs and ask questions if you're not sure.
 - Don't joke about having something you shouldn't, etc. They don't have a sense of humor.
- If you are late, show ticket and ask to go to the front of the line.
- Buy food / drinks AFTER security, but BEFORE the plane (won't count as another carry-on).
 - Extra food on the airplane is limited and expensive; most flights include meals.
- Use airport restroom (nicer than the plane).
- Don't like your seats? Doesn't hurt to ask for a new one at the counter. Be nice and smile... they get yelled at a lot. 😞
- Board early. Overhead space fills up fast, if you plan to use this space board as early as possible.
- Remember to disable roaming (better yet, all cellular) on your phone, unless it's ok on your plan.
- Turn ON "airplane mode" while flying, otherwise your battery may drain *fast*.
- Noise canceling headphones. If you have them, they are amazing and make the trip much better.
- Turn off overhead air when you first sit down (exhaust blows in when the plane backs from gate).
- Many planes have USB and/or power outlets — charge your devices whenever you can.
- Sleep as much as you can. **Stand up and walk around** when you're awake on long flights.
- Drink water 💧, the altitude and the filtered air will dehydrate you. Helps jet leg.
- Know what's next. Especially if your plane is late, know what to do *before* you land.

Passport Control & Customs

When arriving in a country, typically your passport is verified and you must go through customs.

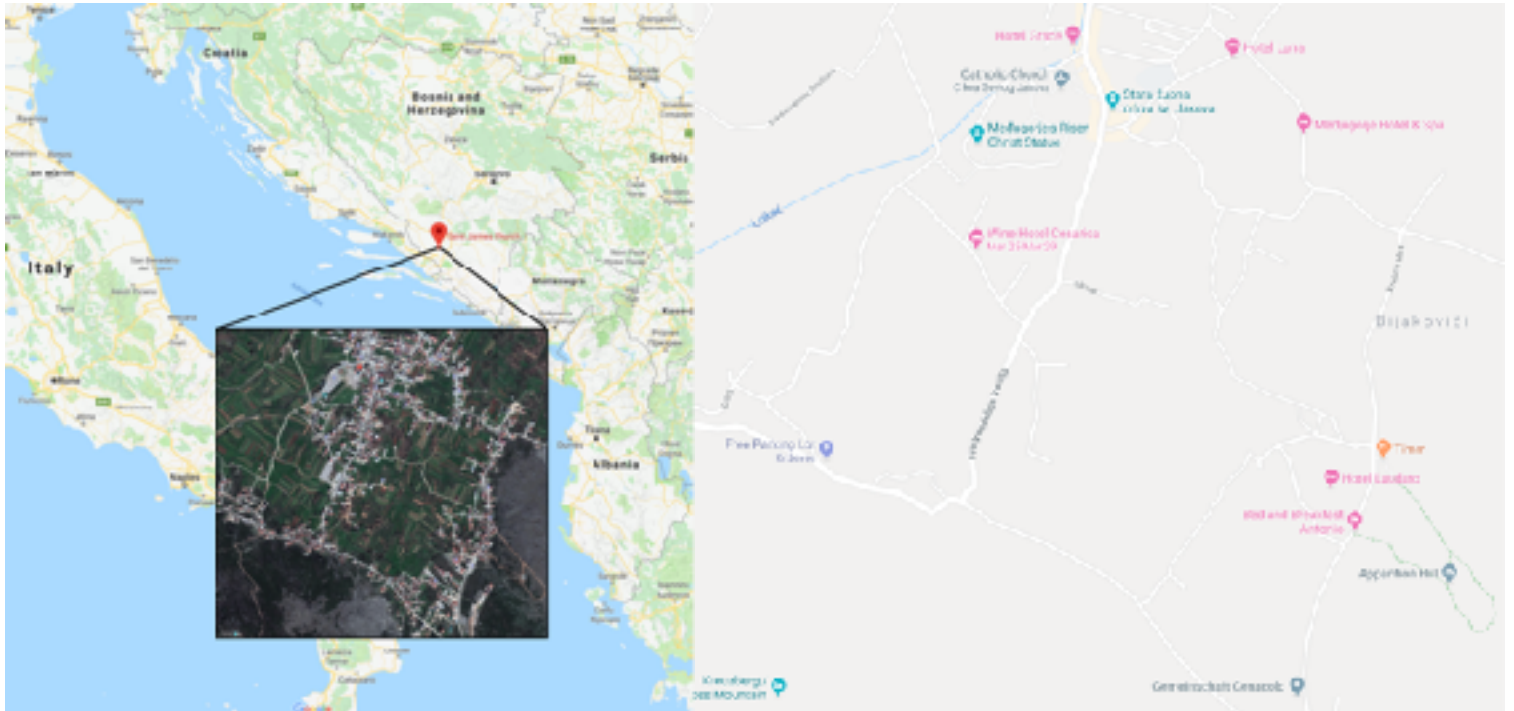
- Families should go through customs together. 1 person present all documents (passports ready).
- Don't joke about having something you shouldn't, etc. They don't have a sense of humor.
- Fill out paperwork (if any) before you get off plane, or as soon as you get it.

Arriving

- Don't forget your bags! International stops require you claim bags *before* customs.
- CONNECT TO AIRPORT WIFI (cellular should probably be off) — Messages are probably waiting for you... tell others about group messages because they probably forgot to connect.
- On connecting flights, Visit your gate before you assume you have extra time. Timezones are confusing!

Maps

- Medjugorje is across the Adriatic Sea from Italy.
- Pansion Dragicevic is near the base of Apparition Hill.
- St. James is about a 15 min walk, or a few minutes by car.

Money

When should I exchange money?

There is no need to exchange money before you leave home. Doing so will likely result in a high exchange rate (expensive). Exchanging money at the airport is also expensive.

So what to do? Use USD, or get local currency during your trip from ATM's. Alternatively, you can go to a bank and exchange money — although if you have a bank card, an ATM is much more convenient. (See "How do I use foreign ATMs" below)

Can I use a Credit Card?

Sometimes. Some of the merchants in Medjugorje only accept cash. Some places will accept credit cards (rental cars, hotels, airports, some shops & restaurants, etc.)

Be sure to let your credit card company / bank know that you are on a trip, or they may decline your purchases. Also know which of your cards charge foreign transaction fees (very expensive in some cases). 3 cards that have no fees are: Citi Costco Visa, Amazon Rewards Visa, Apple Card. They also have varying travel benefits (like insurance). Check your cards to avoid unpleasant surprises. Some debit cards may also charge international fees, be sure to check with your bank.

How do I use foreign ATMs?

There will be ATMs throughout our trip (airports and even next to the St. James in Medjugorje). You can use them as normal, except you should **NOT** choose their "guaranteed" rate — this adds a large additional fee. Instead, choose to accept the exchange rate your bank will charge you. Sometimes this is phrased: "Would you like to withdraw in USD or Marks?" — **choose the local currency, NOT USD**. ATMs will usually charge an access fee \$2 - \$5, it's best to withdraw larger amounts in fewer transactions (your bank may have fees or benefits, check with your bank).

What will I need cash for?

- Gifts and Souvenirs
- Extra food or snacks (the house serves 2 meals per day, breakfast and an early dinner)
- Donations at Mass
- Taxis
- Optional Tips
- Any fees for additional activities

It's good to have some emergency money too, perhaps \$200 per person.

What else do I need to pay?

Phones

Roaming charges can be expensive, especially in Croatia and Bosnia & Herzegovina. You should check with your phone provider before you leave to be sure you understand the fees. If you want to be safe, you can swap your sim card for a "prepaid sim" which turns your phone into a local phone (with a local phone number) for voice, text, and/or data. (Not recommended for most.)

WiFi is widely available (recommended). So, if you turn off cellular service and enable wifi, you will be able to use your phone for everything except SMS (text messages) and phone calls. Messaging apps work fine, *including voice and video calling apps*. See "Pre-trip Checklist" for suggested apps. **Most people will not need cell service.**

A Few Things to see & do

Apparition Hill

- The **Blue Cross** is at the base (there is actually an old and a "new" blue cross). This is where Mirjana used to receive her monthly apparitions.
- The **Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious mysteries** have stations in a loop up on Apparition Hill.
- Near the top, there's a **statue of Our Lady** marking the place where she first appeared in 1981.



Cross Mountain


- More challenging hike.
- There are stops along the hike to stop and pray each of the **stations of the cross**.
- There's a **Cross** at the top, built to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of Jesus's passion.



St. James

- Attend Mass
- Confession
- Adoration
- Veneration of the Cross
- Visit the statues of Mary
- Occasional special talks / events
